

To get your free blues uniform

CAP offers a free blues uniform to new cadets. This uniform includes pants (or skirt for females), belt, shirt and flight cap. You need to supply your own black shoes, socks and deep v-neck t-shirt.

To get your uniform:

- 1) You must first be a member. Turn in your application and be on the National database. Usually Maj. Yaeger will let you know.
- 2) You must establish an account on eServices. To do that go to: <https://www.capnhq.gov/CAP.eServices.Web/Default.aspx> and follow the instructions.
- 3) Once you have an account, go into eServices and find “Cadet Uniform,” possibly on the right side of the page.
- 4) Click on that, then on “Request” and follow the instructions. Be sure to click on “SUBMIT” when you are done.
- 5) Send Maj. Yaeger an email telling him you applied for a uniform. He can check to see if it is in progress.
- 6) The uniform should arrive in a month or so, depending on the number of orders that National Headquarters receives.
